#### **Reviewer's Comment**

Overall quality enhancement in this year's works of PHOCOS 2019

The 4th PHOCOS 2019 International Photo Contest was held under the theme of "Trade and Market of Silk Road". This competition was organized by the Silk Road University Federation for the purpose of rediscovering the society and culture of each country through photography that highlighted the beautiful environment and cultural exchange of the Silk Road. 60 students from 18 universities in 12 countries submitted more than 217 works, and the number of works more than doubled compared to last year.

This year is 180 years since photography was invented. The original inventor of the photograph was officially known as Louis Jacques Mande Daguerre(1787-1185). His 'Daguerreotype' was published worldwide by the Royal French Association (Science Academy) on August 19, 1839, as a standard process for photography. For nearly 200 years, photography has been executed with various types of equipment that captured sight. Today, digital devices play a major role, and after the digital revolution, photography culture has entered a whole new era. As the recipient of photography became the creator, photography made a quantum leap beyond its predecessor in quality and quantity. The works submitted to the competition each year illustrate this fact. The works that capture the scene with creative and original ideas that go beyond the "traditional" of photography confirm the fact that photography is now everyone's.

Digital photography along with smartphone have become universal expressions of people of our time. It has become an important medium for expanding the human eye and for communicating and empathizing quickly. Photographs taken with smartphones in this contest are a meaningful attempt to connect modern times with the Silk Road University Federation.

Three experts were in charge of judging, and here is a brief review. The evaluation method decided by the event organizer is as followed.

- Is it consistent with the topic?
- Did you express the beauty of each country's cultural heritage?
- Are the composition of the theme and background generally natural?
- Are the shooting techniques and interpretations fresh and creative?
- Coordination between universities and countries for diverse exhibitions of entries

According to this evaluation method, the winning works were selected as follows.

The reason for the existence of the market begins with two.: 'Labor and survival'. Those words are even intense, especially during war, and the life of an Afghan mother who is responsible for her family's livelihood!!

The expression "survival stitching" that anyone can sympathize with the shooting skill is back-side light, highlighting the concentration of work with strong contrast and expressing the realism through it. The judges unanimously selected the work due to the overwhelming score difference.

The difference in the exposure of sunlight shining through the eaves in the market alley was well utilized, and the screen composition in the 6x17 panorama size represented the arrangement of objects and people well.

The portrait of the mother who was captured in the moment with a smartphone is a good representation of the mother's life in Nepal, and the screen is corrected through photo retouching. The artist's attempt to see life and the ecological environment from a different perspective is well represented.

As mentioned above, the evaluation was mainly focused on choosing winners. As the judges, we tried to evaluate fairly according to the judging criteria set by the event organizer. However, the selection is based on the judge's preferences and is not absolute. Even if you don't win, you would still have created a beautiful piece of art. However, it needs to be said that the selection of overlapping photographs was selected according to the selection criteria, and works that used novelty and camera equipment were selected first. Congratulations again to the winners.

#### FarKhonda Malekzada\*

An Afghan woman aged 27, accused of burning the Holly Quran in Kabul, tens of wrathful men attacked and killed her and burnt her dead body in Kabul's river on
